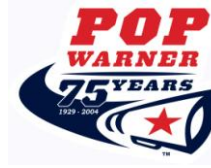

2011 Registration and Equipment Use Fees:

Registration and equipment use fee for **new participants** is \$225.00*

Registration and equipment use fee for **returning participants** is \$200.00*

Total fee for **Returning Midget participants** is \$100.00*

Prompt payment of fees enables Coyote Creek to meet its financial obligations to the conference and equipment manufactures. **No protective gear will be issued until the equipment use fee has been paid.** There will not be any exceptions to this rule.

Your place on the roster will not be secure until your registration fee is paid in full.

**All fees are nonrefundable.*

Additional Cheerleading Fees:

The cheerleading program requires additional fees that are in addition to the registration and equipment use fee. The fee is still to be finalized.

Divisional Ages and Weights:

The ages and weights for football players (the ages apply for cheerleaders, but not the weights) in each division of play are as follows:

Please be advised that the CCYS philosophy is to have a player participate in the lowest age/weight division possible, so that his or her opportunity to compete will be enhanced. The final decision as to which division a player is assigned will be made in consultation between the player's parents and the CCYS Boys and Girls Athletic Directors.

Sports Physical:

A Sports Physical must be obtained by July 31, 2011 to certifying the player to participate in contact sport, tackle football, is required prior to participation by any player in any practice. If you have health care coverage through an HMO or a PPO, such as Kaiser, Aetna, etc., it is probably more economical to use the service. However, you must take the Medical Examination Release Form to your physician; the form is available online at: www.ccys.com

Birth Certificate/Photo:

***Original birth certificates are required to be certified by Peninsula Pop Warner.** If you were not born in Santa Clara County and do not have a certified original birth certificate copy, you should immediately send for a certified copy from the county or country that you were born in.

***A current photo is required.** Wallet size is preferred: no Polaroid's.

Pop Warner Scholastic Program

Please bring a copy of your child's **Report Card (2010 - 2011 full year)** for the school year ending 2010. Report cards are mandatory for the PPW Little Scholar program. This is used for players/cheerleader play-off eligibility and scholastic recognition. If your child has a Grade Point Average below 2.0, you will have to complete a Scholastic Parent / Player Contract in order to participate in the Pop Warner Program.

Volunteer Hours:

Parents are required to volunteer a minimum of eight (8) hours in order for your child to participate in Coyote Creek football and cheerleading.
